"Run, Jane! Run this way."

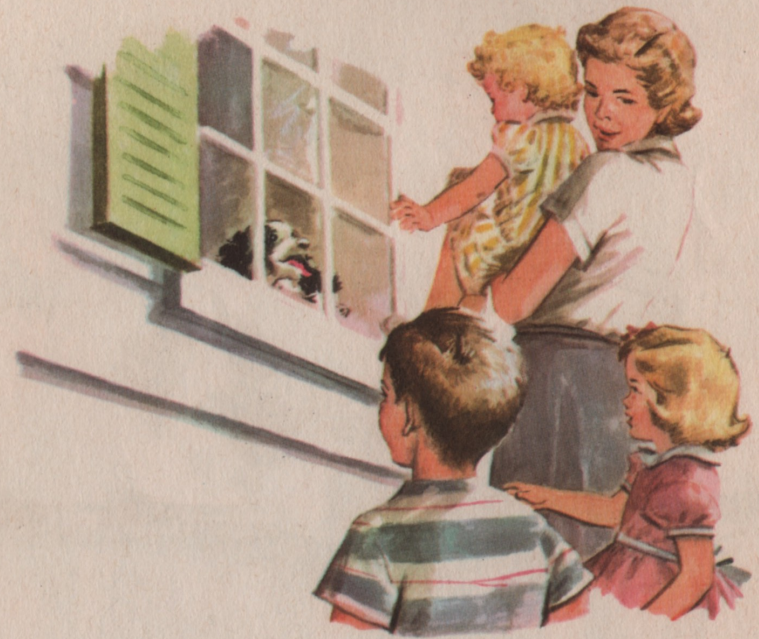




Dick and Jane looked this way,
