Then you will not get lost.

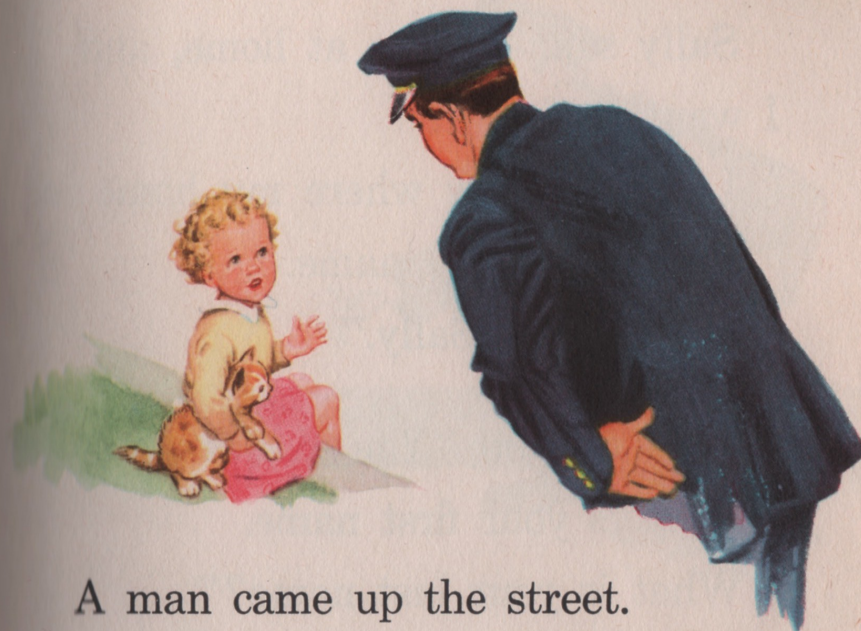
We will walk and walk and walk."
